### CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

*We are looking for six young scientists – two each from Germany, Russia, and the United States – in the fields of chemistry, physics and astronomy (other STEM subjects welcome as well) to share their passion for science with a broad and intercultural audience at an unconventional and enjoyable evening event in an iconic Berlin venue.*

**What is the Trilateral Science Slam?** It's a fun event with a succession of rapid-fire presentations of original research by young scientists from Germany, Russia and the U.S. in their native languages – on stage in front of a live and curious audience. It is a chance to let personality shine in a max-10-minute performance by each “Slammer”, who delivers an exciting and approachable version of otherwise complex research. “Slammers” compete for the hearts and minds of the audience, whose applause determines the winner!

**What do you need?** Original research in your area of expertise, courage and joy in sharing your passion for science with the general public. You should be able to arrive in Berlin on Saturday, 16 June and remain until Tuesday, 19 June to take part in coaching sessions and rehearsals prior to the Slam. Applicants selected to participate in the Slam will be provided round-trip travel to and accommodation in Berlin.

**How do you benefit?** Personal coaching on presentation skills and working with an interpreter from experienced Science Slam show producers; exposure for your own research and to other cutting-edge science; and networking with scientific colleagues from other fields and countries.

The Trilateral Science Slam is part of the Fulbright-Cottrell Second Junior Faculty Professional Development Workshop taking place in Berlin from 18 to 20 June, 2018. “Slammers” are welcome to attend the workshop.
